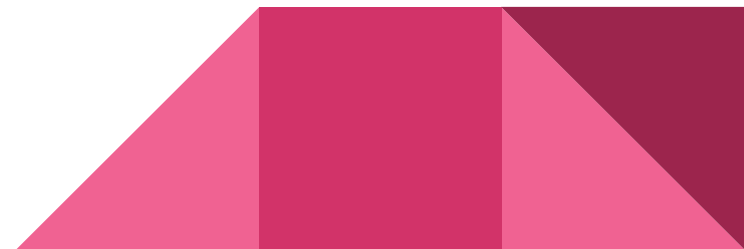
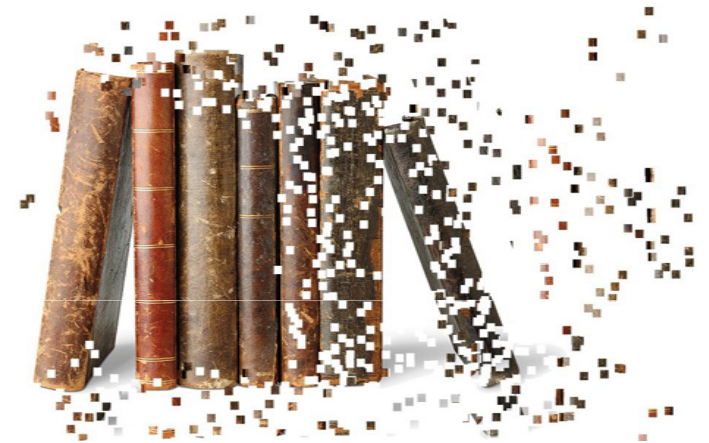

- open practices.

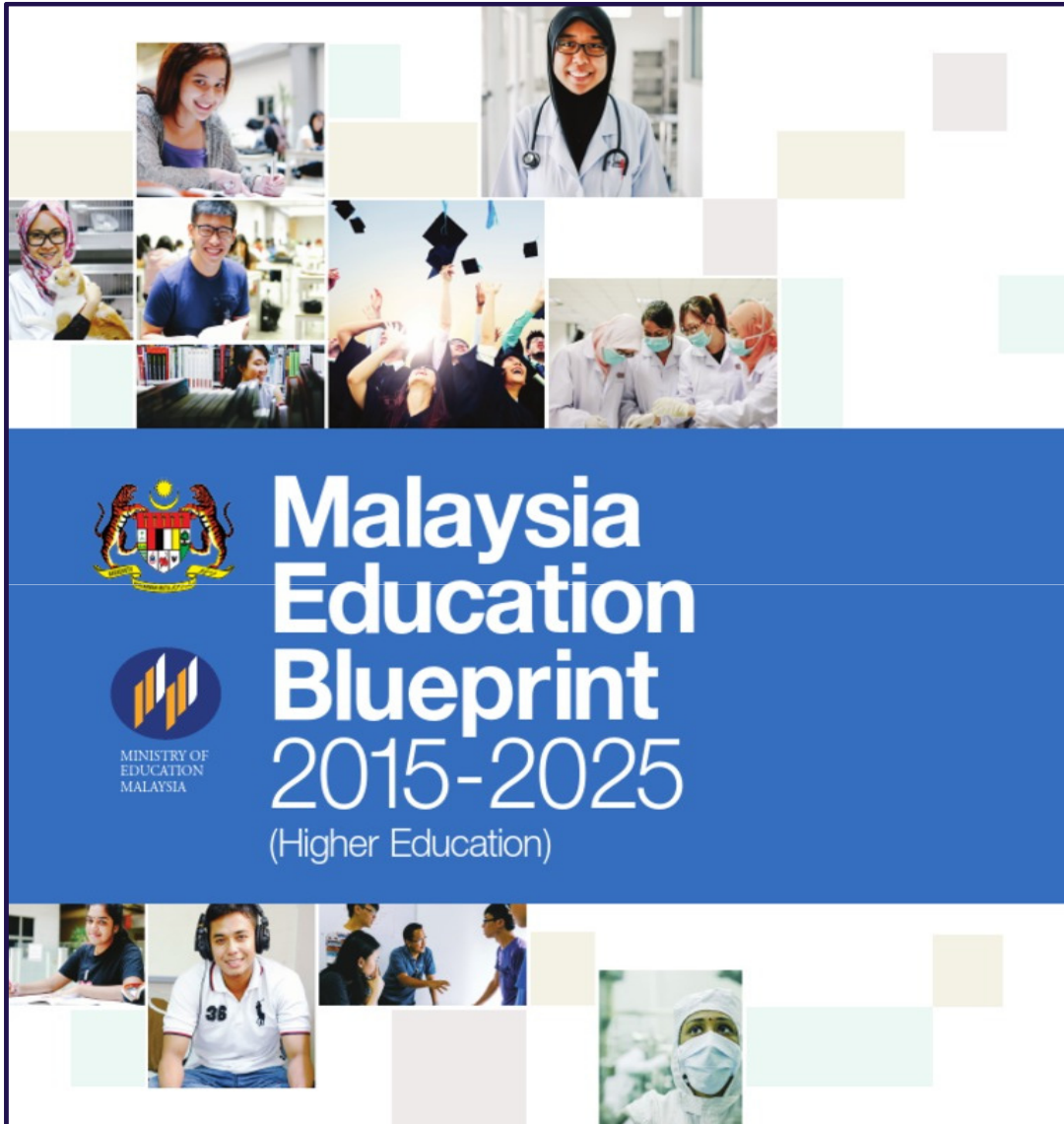




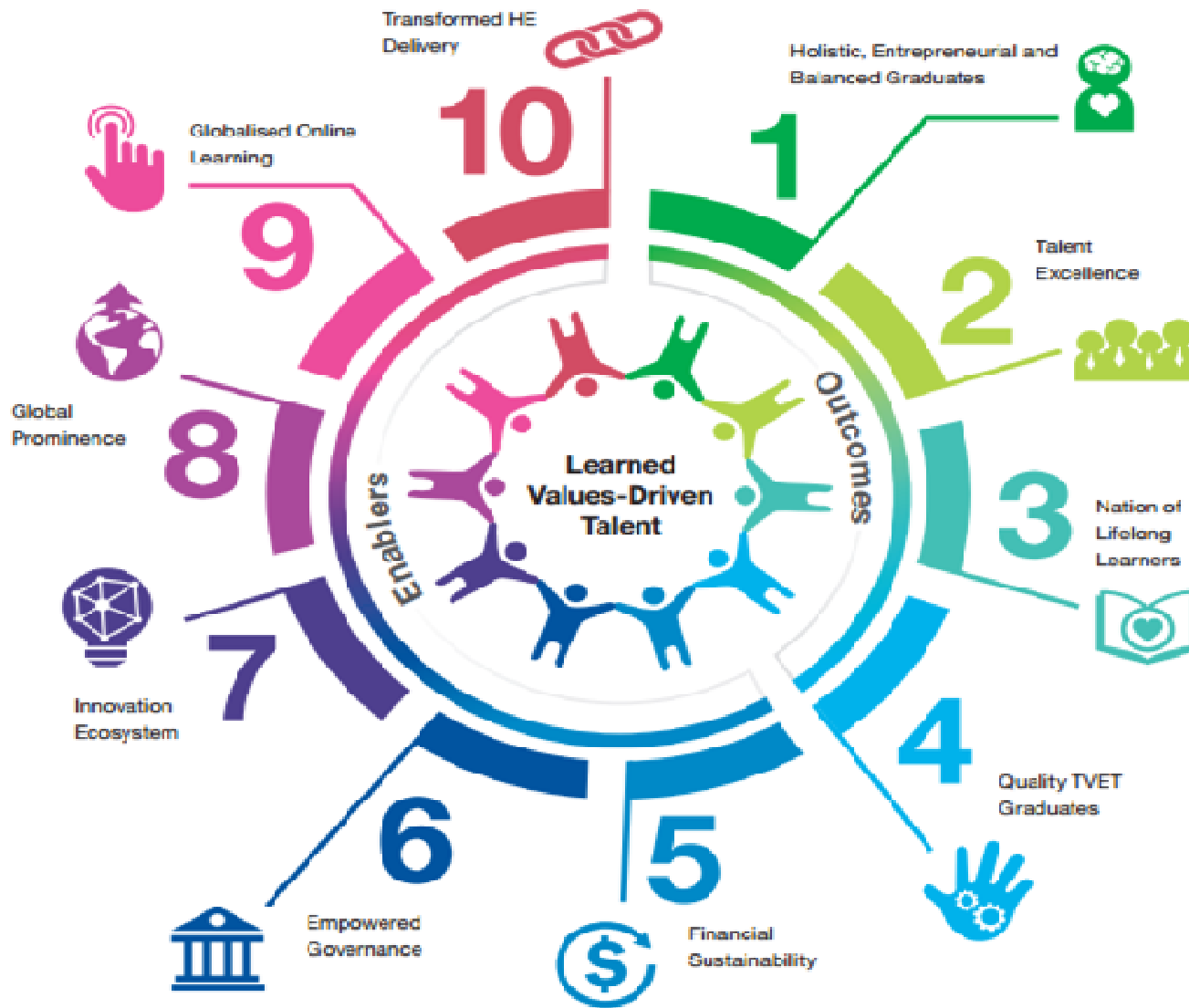
FRAMING MALAYSIAN HIGHER EDUCATION 4.0

MOHE recognises that higher education needs to evolve in tandem with the 4IR in order to stay relevant and competitive.

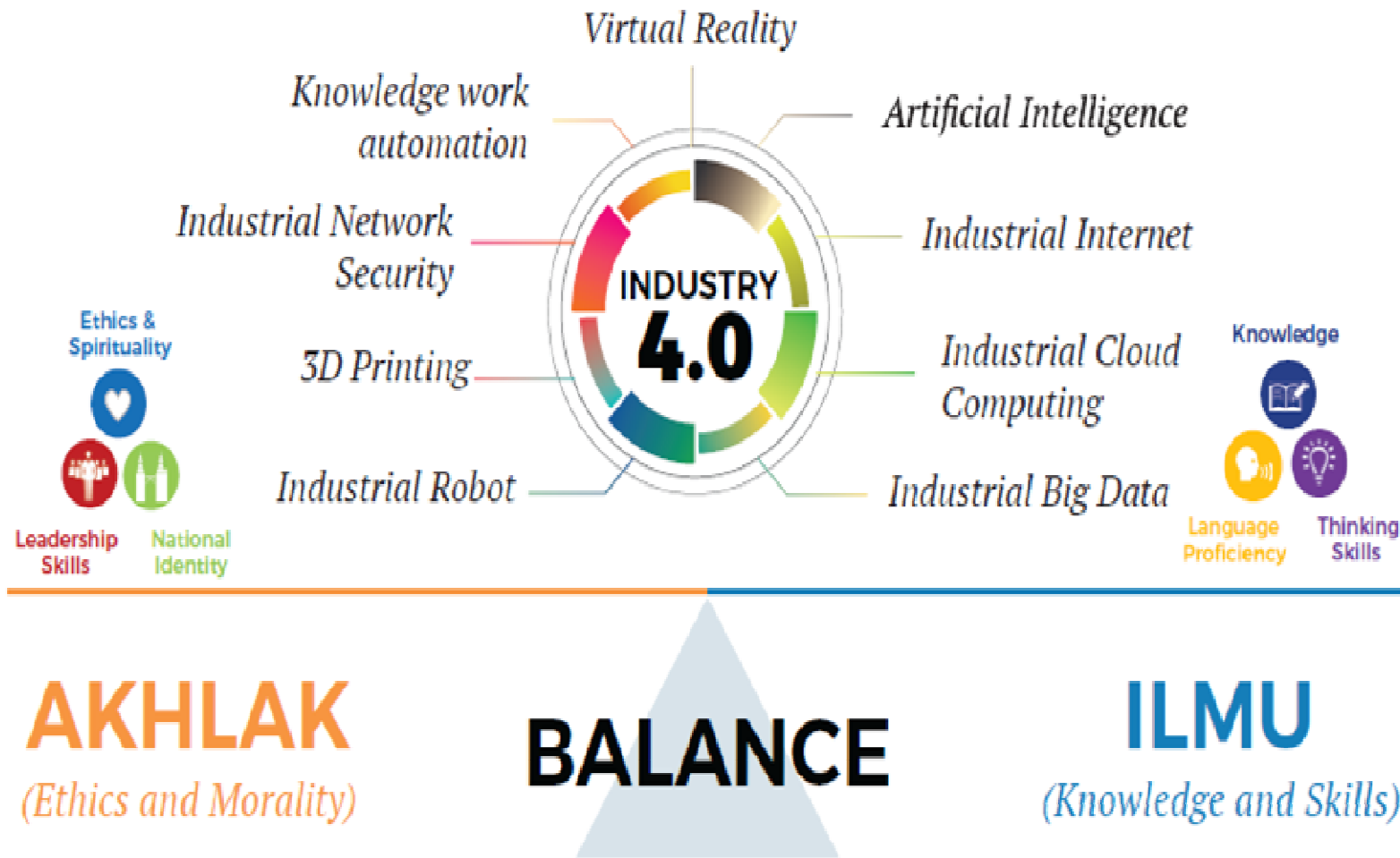

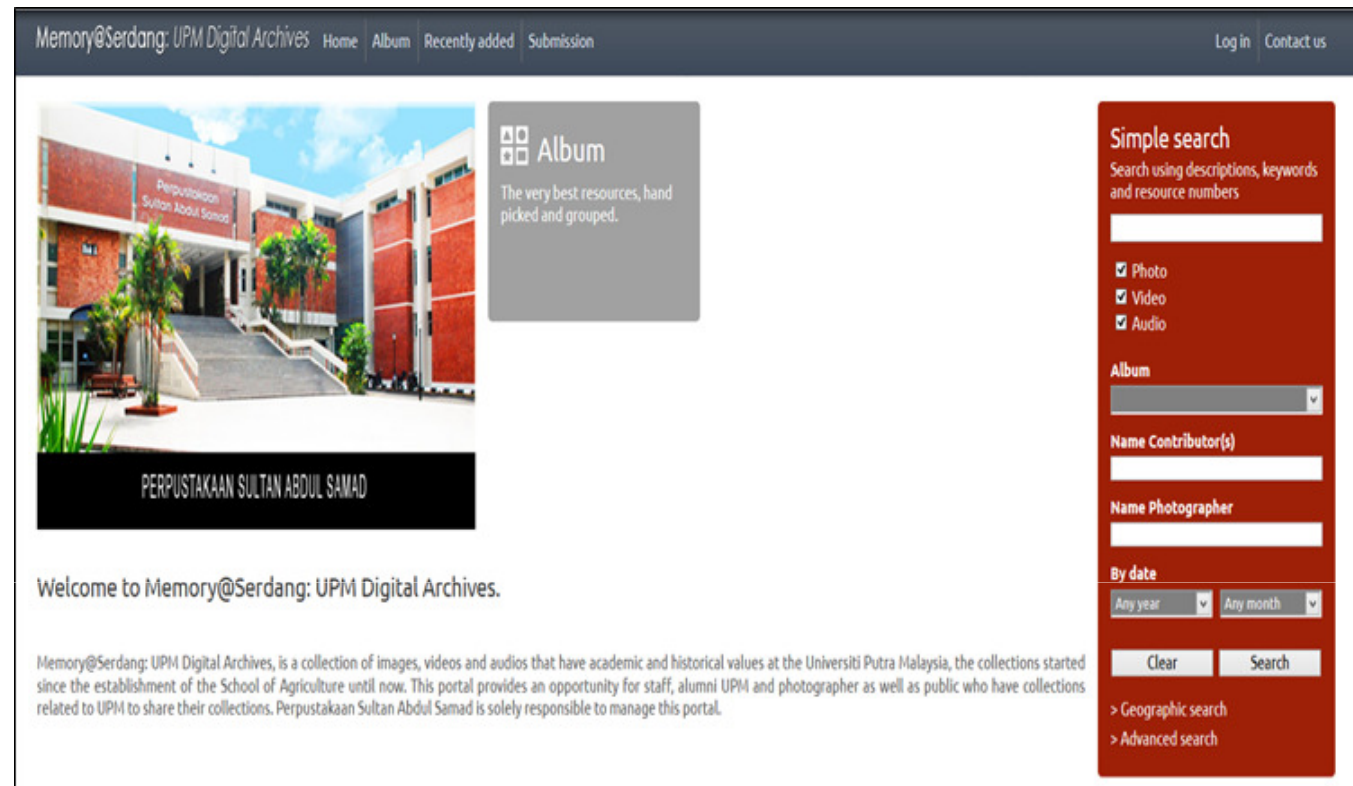
AGRIS (International Information System for Agricultural Science and Technology)


