Face-to-Face with RIA

Similar with the concept of book-a-librarian, Face-to-Face with RIA is also available for consultation or one-on-one available in the Libraries from Monday to Friday, 09:00am to 06:00pm.

Make an appointment with RIA.

This service is limited to helping patrons find answers to research questions, bibliographic and technology instruction, and reader's advisory. As such, it will not cover the following: (a) computer configuration, maintenance, and troubleshooting; (b) provision of investment, legal, or medical advice; (c) tutoring or homework help; and, (d) job interview preparation.

To book a session (which lasts for about 30 to 60 minutes), follow these three simple steps. Note that an activated MyLibrary account is required in booking for an appointment.

Booking should be made at least three working days before the intended date of consultation.

Patrons are entitled to avail of a maximum of two appointments per month.

The Libraries reserves the right to cancel an appointment made by a patron who fails to show up within the first 15 minutes of the scheduled consultation session.





Request for Document Delivery

DOCUMENT DELIVERY is a fee-based service for UP and non-UP library users. The document delivery service processes articles and book chapter requests from the journals, books, e-resources and other materials available only in UP Diliman Libraries. These documents are scanned and can be picked up in person or sent electronically via email.

Requests may be sent to the Information Services and Instruction Section (ISaIS) through email at libraryinfo.updiliman@up.edu.ph with the specific information regarding the material being requested. This includes the title of the article/chapter, the journal/book where it appeared, place and date of publication, page numbers to be requested, and other pertinent details. The Reference Librarian will search iLib Web OPAC, find the article or book chapter and deliver it via email or courier.

Requests from students from other schools, private and government researchers shall be made through their office's or school's Head Librarian.

- Set-up charge
 - . US\$ 10.00 for first 50 pages per article
 - IIS\$ 1.00 for every 10 additional pages beyond first 50.






